



Rabbit Caretaker Agreement

OUR PURPOSE is to promote the welfare of domestic rabbits.

WE BELIEVE that rabbits deserve to be treated with compassion and valued as companion animals.

OUR GOALS ARE:

- ? To educate the public about the physical and social needs of domestic rabbits.
- ? To promote the adoption of homeless rabbits from foster homes, shelters, and rescue groups into loving homes.
- ? To reduce rabbit overpopulation by promoting rabbit spays and neuters.

WE SUPPORT EACH OTHER in attaining these goals with free and open communication and by demonstrating mutual respect and consideration.



The following agreement is made between Rabbit Advocates and _____, rabbit caretaker, who can no longer keep his/her rabbit but is willing to temporarily house the rabbit until a new home is located.

_____, rabbit caretaker, agrees to:

1. Have rabbit spayed/neutered and provide all necessary medical care.
2. Allow for home visits by a Rabbit Advocate volunteer and by potential adopters.
3. Make available a photo and text for the Rabbit Advocates webpage.
4. Follow up with potential adopters referred by Rabbit Advocates.
5. Inform Rabbit Advocates when the rabbit is adopted.
6. Not release the rabbit outdoors, but to contact Rabbit Advocates to make emergency arrangements if time runs out.
7. Transport the rabbit to adoption outreaches or make arrangements to transport.

RABBIT ADVOCATES agrees to:

1. Assign a Rabbit Advocate volunteer to assist in rehoming the rabbit. The volunteer will:
 - a. make a home visit to determine the adoptability of the rabbit;
 - b. determine what kind of adoption criteria would be acceptable to the rabbit caretaker;
 - c. be the contact person for potential adopters, provide information about the rabbit, review applications;
 - d. stay in touch with the rabbit caretaker, forward recommended applications to them.
2. Display rabbit photo and text on webpage.
3. Sponsor adoption outreaches for the rabbit.
4. Provide educational materials to the new adopter.

All efforts listed above will be used to find an acceptable home; however there is no guarantee that a home will be found for the rabbit. Rabbit Advocates may discontinue this agreement at any time, for any reason.
